Donations through the Tokyo Marathon 2023 Charity will be used to fund construction of “dream houses,” where children with long-term illnesses can stay with their parents out of the hospital ward while still connected to the necessary medical equipment and also to maintain and operate existing facilities.

Tokyo Marathon 2023 Charity Application Procedures & Schedule

About Tokyo Marathon Charity

This is an initiative to expand the circle of charity activities through the Tokyo Marathon. You can support this initiative by making donations. Those who donate more than the amount specified by the charity organization and wish to run as a Charity Runner, may be selected as a Charity Runner and asked to promote the charity activities while participating in the event.

Charity Runner Eligibility

- Registration as a charity runner (entry) is optional.
- Eligibility for the Tokyo Marathon 2023: Must be at least 19 years of age on the race day.
Be capable of completing the race within 6 hours and 30 minutes.
- All runners are also required to adhere to all respective Tokyo Marathon 2023 regulations and guidelines.

Charity Runner: 100,000 yen or more per Charity Runner

Donation only: 1,000 yen or more

Step1: Apply from the charity donation system.

Application Entry Period : Jul. 11 (Mon) until Aug. 31 (Wed), 2022.

Step 2: Make a donation by Bank transfer.

Donation payment period: Jul. 11 (Mon) until Aug. 31 (Wed), 2022.

[Charity Runner Applicants who wish to make a donation application and also wish to run the event as a Charity Runner.]

Check the charity runner application page of the charity organization and select a program to donate.

Step 1: Apply from the charity donation system.

- Application Entry Period : Jul. 11 (Mon) until Jul. 24 (Sun), 2022.
- Step 2: The charity organization selects runners and notifies them to make a donation.
Notification date: Jul. 25 (Mon) until Jul. 27 (Wed), 2022.
- Step 3: Make a donation by bank transfer.
Donation payment period: Jul. 25 (Mon) until Aug. 5 (Fri), 2022.
- Step 4: Complete the entry registration as a charity runner.
*In addition to donations, the Tokyo Marathon 2023 event fee will also be charged.
Runner Entry Period: Aug. 8 (Mon) until Aug. 19 (Fri), 2022
Entry Fee Payment Period: Oct. 19 (Wed) until Oct. 28 (Fri), 2022.
- Step 5: Packet Pick-up *Advanced reservation required
Dates : Mar. 2 (Thu) until Mar. 4 (Sat), 2023.
- Step 6: Tokyo Marathon 2023 Race Day : Mar. 5 (Sun), 2023.

Family House began in 1991, as an idea from the families of patients undergoing treatment at the in the Pediatric Department at the National Cancer Center Hospital, and it has served over 280,000 people over the past 31 years.

Due to advances in modern medicine, previously incurable childhood diseases have become treatable, which has led to increasing numbers of children with lengthy hospital stays, as well as those who must stay close to the hospital even while receiving outpatient care.

This has inspired Family House to strive towards providing “Dream House”, a warm, welcoming second home for families located in proximity to and in collaboration with associated medical facilities at which they are receiving medical care. We began working towards this goal from locations close to the National Cancer Center in Chuo City Tokyo, applying the accumulated experience we have gained over the years providing for patient needs to cover a broader network of medical centers and locations.

“Dream House” is a house that is located within walking distance to hospitals, so that even patients who cannot leave the hospital can be near their families while receiving the necessary medical treatment and care.

In order for us as in society as a whole to support the young patients and their families who battle against life-threatening illnesses, we seek out monetary donations in various ways, such as through the generous participation in Tokyo Marathon 2023 Charity .
